## Part 4

### Use of Quotation Marks “ ” and Commas , in dialogues

“ If you set me free , I will help you some day , ” said Fox.

“ You have the sweetest voice , ” Fox said in the kindest and softest voice .

“ Thank you for setting me free , ” the mouse said .

If the direct speech (直述句) is at the beginning of the sentence, put the **comma before the final quotation mark**. (Don't use a full stop here.)

Fox said to Crow , “ Don't always believe what others say and don't be too proud ! ”

Fox laughed , “ Ha ! Ha ! You are not a lion . ”

Crow asked , “ How can I drink the water ? ”

Use ‘comma’ after the introductory clause (開端的子句) .
